DEDICATION

In October 1971 the West End House Boys Club, which had relocated from the old West End of Boston, opened its doors in the Allston-Brighton area. Soon thereafter a large number of boys from the newly constructed Charlesview Apartments (also known as Stadium Way) joined the Club; many of them also attended the camp.

Charlesview, Inc., the sponsoring agency, is a nonprofit organization which is comprised of three area religious institutions: Congregation Kadimah Toras-Moshe, St. Anthony's Roman Catholic Church, and Brighton Community United Methodist Church. The apartments were located in the North Allston neighborhood, next to Harvard University. Recently, through a real estate agreement with Harvard, Charlesview, Inc. and its partners redeveloped the apartment complex less than a half mile from its original location.

One of the founding members of Charlesview, Inc. was Rabbi Abraham Halbfinger, a man who was as deeply devoted to the well-being of individuals and families of all faiths as he was to the principles of his religion. He remained active with the Charlesview program until his death in 2012. In 2013 *The Rabbi Abraham Halbfinger and Charlesview Charitable Fund* was created to strengthen, deepen and grow relationships among low and moderate income individuals who live in Allston and Brighton.

West End House Camp is fortunate to be a recipient in 2014 of support from this fund to be used for the 2015 camp season.

Rabbi Halbfinger was a well known and highly respected leader both in the Jewish community and in the social work community. He was very familiar with the West End House and had been a guest at many of our functions. We are proud and honored to be the recipient of support in his memory and to work with Charlesview, Inc. to fulfill the mission of the Fund.

The Vuvuzelas were back at it again for World Cup 2014. Unlike the real World Cup, in which Germany beat Argentina, the West End World Cup ended with a China vs. Italy final match. This year's World Cup marked the 1st time a former camper coached his former team (Joey Cohen). Brion Rock had been the only coach ever in China history and passed on his veteran squad to his former player, similar to Jim Calhoun handing off his UConn team to his former player, Kevin Ollie (UConn won the 2014 National Championship). Team China has always had a solid squad, but always lost momentum, in shocking fashion, in their Handball match each year to Team Brazil.

In the World Division, China and Brazil made the semi-finals. Brazil is probably the most celebrated West End World Cup team with 3 semi-final appearances already in 5 years. 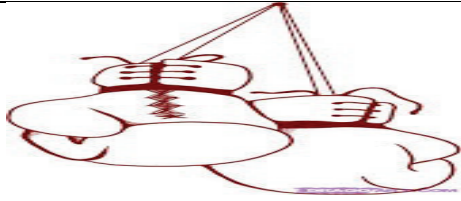

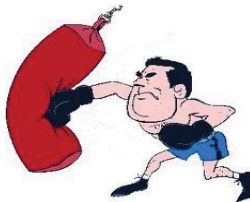
